PANTUSO DANCE LEVELS & NOTES

EXPERIENCED DANCE STUDENTS (CHILDREN & YOUTH)

Following our studio philosophy, we use a class designation system that will help students concentrate on being the best dancer possible rather than a "level" of dance. All of our classes, for students with moderate to extensive experience and skills, are given fun class names that relate to an aspect of each discipline (ex: Ballet Allegro, Tap Scuffle, Jazz Lindy etc).

We have grouped students in these classes according to a number of factors including: skill, confidence, experience, technique, age, performance quality, dedication, behaviour and class dynamic. This process starts in January and there is an extensive amount of thought and consideration put into composing classes. Our goal is to give students the best dance experience possible in a learning environment that that will help each student reach their full potential.

Experienced students that are new to Pantuso Dance should contact Kelly to set-up an assessment.

BEGINNING STUDENTS & STEPS CLASSES (CHILDREN & YOUTH)

Our series of classes for students who are just starting out or are continuing to work on the fundamental skills is called "Steps". Each of our dance disciplines has a series of Steps classes with designated age groups. All new students are able to register in any age-appropriate Steps program Please note that it is normal for students to be in Steps classes for 2 or more seasons.

Steps classes are registered by age group and based on the age the student will be on December 31.

If you want to register for a dance discipline that you have not taken and is a higher skill bracket than Steps, please contact Kelly to be directed towards the appropriate class or to set up an assessment.

ADULT CLASSES

We are very happy to offer classes for adults (post high-school and up) in Ballet, Broadway Jazz, Contemporary, Jazz, Lyrical Hip Hop, Tap and RAD Discovering Repertoire. Please see the "Adult" section for information on these classes.

CO-REQUISITES & CLASS ICONS

Ballet technique is a fundamental skill required for many dance styles. In order for our students to progress and achieve their full potential, Ballet is a co-requisite for some of our Jazz and Contemporary classes for experienced students. Jazz is a co-requisite for Lyrical, along with Ballet.

GROOVE 2025 (YEAR-END RECITAL): DATE TBA

Groove 2025 is our annual recital at the Sid Williams Theatre that showcases the dedication and hard work of our recital students throughout the year. It consists of three evening performances and, possibly, one Saturday matinee. Groove will be either Thursday May 1 to Saturday May 3 or Thursday May 9 to Saturday May 10, plus mandatory rehearsal starting the Sunday prior. We will have exact dates given to us by the Sid Williams Theatre in June.

Participation in Groove is mandatory for all recital classes (excluding tech, RAD and seasonal programs). A large portion of class time is spent on recital choreography and all students are required to take part.

All Groove recital students, that attend Picture Day, receive a complimentary class photo.

Detailed Groove rehearsal and performance schedules will be sent out after the Christmas break.

MASTERCLASS: MARCH 2 & 3

Pantuso Dance is happy to host our very own dance festival every year. This event gives Pantuso students the opportunity to experience a positive, encouraging dance festival with professional adjudicators. MasterClass does not have student entry fees thanks to full sponsorship from the Pantuso Parent Auxiliary.

All recital classes will be participating in MasterClass on March 2. All Pantuso Performance Works groups will be participating in MasterClass on March 3.

SHINE: MARCH 7

Our Pantuso Performance Works and Ensemble students will be performing in Shine at the Sid Williams Theatre. This is our showcase of invitational solos, duets and small groups that learn choreography outside of regular class time.

PANTUSO REGISTRATION & POLICIES

Registration for current Pantuso families begins on Sunday April 28, 8:00am. Registration for new families begins on Saturday May 4, 8:00am.

NEW STUDENTS

All new students are welcome to register in any Steps program.

If the new student has prior dance experience and would like to be placed in a class with like-skilled peers, they must book an assessment (for each program) prior to registering (\$25 fee per assessment). This is to ensure that students are placed in the appropriate program for their ability.

TUITION FEES

A non-refundable deposit of \$50 per student, per class is required at the time of registration.

The balance of payments are due August 1 or you can schedule payments that will be charged on the first of each month (August 1 to March 1). Payments will be accepted by credit card, e-transfer, cheque or cash. Registrants will be sent payment information in July.

Tuition fees will not be split between multiple payers as it creates too many administrative challenges. Thank you for working out family finances outside of dance tuition fees.

Payments for any classes in the Preschool Program are due by the first class.

GST will be added to the listed tuition fees.

A charge of 30 will be applied to NSF cheques and declined credit cards.

Those using any subsidy or homeschool funding must notify us by July 15. We will send information

reguarding procedures to use these resources.

REFUNDS

There are no tuition fee refunds for our full year programs after October 15 (except for medical reasons). Monthly payments after this date will continue for all withdrawals until the last payment on March 1.

Refunds prior to October 15 will receive a pro-rated refund (based on monthly payments starting August 1), minus the class deposits. Class deposits are non-refundable.

DISCOUNTS

Those that pay their tuition in full (one payment excluding deposit) using *cash, cheque or e-transfer only,* by August 1 are entitled to a 3% discount. Please note that the 3% discount doesn't apply to those paying by credit card due to high merchant fees or those using Jumpstart subsidy, home school funding or other subsidy programs or seasonal preschool and adult programs.

A 10% mulit-class discount on course fees is available to students taking 2 or more classes. Please note the multi-class discount does not apply to those using Jumpstart subsidy, home school funding or other subsidy or seasonal preschool and adult programs.

In addition to the above discounts, individual students taking 9 or more programs will be charged for the first 8 programs only (9th, 10th etc. least expensive classes will be complimentary). This and all discounts excludes Performance Works, Ensemble, Summer Intensives and workshops.

COSTUME FEES

Classes participating in the year-end recital will be billed a costume fee. Please note the costume fees include the cost of the costume, tights (if required), alterations, labour, duties, taxes and shipping.

To find out the costume fee for your class, please refer to the letter code after the date and time information for each class listed in this guide.

Tier A: \$80 Tier B: \$85 Tier C: \$90 Tier D: \$100

Costume fees are due November 1.

CLASS TIMES AND HOLIDAYS

Our 24/25 dance season starts on Tuesday September 3. Depending on Groove recital dates, the last day of classes will be either Friday May 9 or Saturday May 10.

Class times and days are subject to change. Please check our website for current information.

Classes do not run on stat holidays except for Monday February 17 (Family Day) and Monday April 21 (Easter Monday). Classes run as usual on all school professional days.

Christmas Break: Tuesday December 17 to Sunday January 5.

Spring Break: Saturday March 22 to Sunday March 30 (classes run the first week of Spring Break).

Students are expected to miss no more than four classes throughout the year.

PANTUSO SUMMER DANCE INTENSIVE

Prepare to sweat in our multi-disciplinary camps. An intensive for intermediate to advanced students. Work on ballet, contemporary, hip hop, jazz, lyrical, and conditioning throughout the week (note that you do not need experience in hip hop to participate).

Students will also develop their own choreography with the guidance of our instructors. They will complete the week with a show (in costume) for family and friends.

Students in the following ballet classes for the 24/25 dance season are eligible: Allegro, Coupé, Frappé and Tendu or with permission.

ENSEMBLE AUDITIONED PROGRAM

Pantuso Ensemble is a supplementary training program designed to push the technical and artistic abilities of our higher level dancers. It includes advanced technique as well as choreography. Ensemble performs in Groove MasterClass and Shine, as well as other performance opportunities throughout the year. Students should expect group and independent rehearsals (as assigned) in addition to class time.

Ensemble is by invitation after audition, and students who are accepted into this program must make a full time commitment to it.

Minimum Requirements

- Ballet Allegro, Coupé or Frappé or with permission.
- Mandatory enrollment in Contemporary, Ballet, Jazz, Lyrical and Jumps & Turns (preference given to students in RAD and tech classes as well).

DID YOU KNOW?

We will organize students into appropriate age and skill-based groupings. A detailed camp schedule will be sent in July.

All Ensemble students should be registered in this camp unless they already have previously scheduled holidays.
